Douglas County and Roseburg are located on Interstate 5 in Southern Oregon. While largely rural (and beautiful), the County has numerous large, well-served [industrial sites](#); a highly-[motivated workforce](#); and good [transportation options](#). Douglas County has very low industrial land costs (\$50,000-\$75,000 per acre)—[with credits available for job creation when purchasing County-owned land](#)— and **NO County-wide System Development Charges or impact fees**.
